The East Preston Empowerment Academy's main mission has been to support the Black community of East Preston. Primarily by providing people with the proper education needed to succeed in the future. Education is something that has been neglected for Black people for generations due to systemic oppression and lack of government support. Luckily the EPEA provides a solid learning curriculum with their Adult Learning Programs or ALP for short. These programs range from a multitude of various subject including math, writing, and history. What makes EPEA's ALP unique is their focus on providing a mostly Afrocentric learning course load.

The reason behind this is due to the current education system, as black history is not always taught or even talked about in the curriculum. This lack of education and understanding of their own history or culture is one of the reasons why Black people feel left out when it comes to learning. But the Adult Learning Program helps Black people receive the education that they have always deserved, through a new online format. When participants register for the program, they are formally interviewed by the instructors to assess their level of knowledge on the subject matter they are taking. This assessment helps the instructors know where it would be best to place participants and to make the learning process easier. While it is common for some participants to struggle with the course material, the instructors are always available to assist them in understanding what it is they might be having difficulty with. While there have been some barriers due to the new online learning format, EPEA continues to overcome the pandemic by making it easier for people to share their work online for everyone to review. This helps create flexibility between the participants and their busy schedule.

These programs also help individuals get their GED. Unfortunately, there are some people who haven't had the opportunity to finish high school depending on their circumstance. So, this program allows adults to be able to receive their GED, which in turn allows them to show their completion in education and to look more credible on a resume. It also shows that they have been certified to pass high school.

The importance of having an Adult Learning Program like this is extremely important for Black communities. At EPEA their number one goal is to continuously give back to the community and to inspire people to reach their true potential. So, if you are looking for a program that helps you receive the proper education that you have been unable to receive, then look no further than the East Preston Empowerment Academy.
